



The Adventurous Play Experience (APE) project is a scrap play project operating throughout the Bradford District.

We play with scrap materials which have been reclaimed from the local environment (streets, skips, tips and businesses) and are put together in play packs.

We offer 3 services which are all free of charge to settings with children aged 0-18 in the Bradford district.

Play Sessions

We will come to your setting to run a play session using our resources. We provide everything that will be needed and all the setting needs to provide is the children, a space and staff to support.

Children are encouraged to play with the resources however they want to and have complete freedom to play.

Sessions can be tailored to meet your needs; this can be discussed when making the booking.

Loan Packs

We can bring you a loan pack of scrap resources to use for a period of time for free. The loans can be short-term days to weeks or permanent, depending on your needs. Delivery and pick up can be arranged so all you need to do is find somewhere to put them and then have fun with the resources!

Training Workshops

We can also provide informal training to setting staff should they want to learn more about scrap loose parts play and take it forward in their setting.

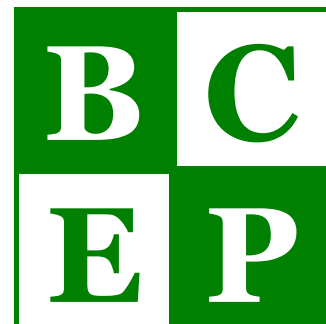
The training workshops will cover; play theory, scrap play ideas, health and safety, risk assessment and where to source scrap materials.
